

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to requirement 20 U.S.C. 1412 (a) (10) of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 (IDEA 2004) representatives of Nonpublic Schools are invited to timely and meaningful consultations with the below listed Public School Districts regarding decisions that affect the location, identification, and provision of services to parentally-placed private school children attending private schools within the jurisdiction of the below listed Public School Districts.

The following topics will be discussed during the consultation process:

- How parentally placed private school children suspected of having a disability can participate equitably in special education and related services
- How parents, teacher, and private school officials will be informed of the process
- The determination of the proportionate amount of federal funds available to serve parentally placed private school children with disabilities, including determination of how the amount was calculated
- How the process will operate throughout the school year to ensure that parentally placed private school children with disabilities through the child find process can participate in special education and related services
- How, where, and by whom special education and related services will be provided for parentally placed children with disabilities
- How to conduct the annual count of the number of parentally-placed private school children with disabilities
- How such services will be apportioned if funds are insufficient to serve all children and how and when these decisions will be made

If the local education agency disagrees with the views of the private school officials on the provision of services or types of services, how the local education agency shall provide a written explanation of reasons why the local educational agency chose not to provide services directly or through a contract to the private school officials.
